


Who is Who in the Alberta Condo World?

<u>Service Alberta</u> is the government ministry responsible for condominium legislation in the Province. They administer the


- Condominium Property Act (CPA) and,

The Real Estate Council of Alberta



The <u>Real Estate Council of Alberta</u> is an independent governing authority, authorized by Service Alberta, that regulates and enforce standards for real estate brokerage, mortgage brokerage and condominium property management in Alberta.

Real Estate Institute of Canada (REIC) is "the only national provider of advanced education and designation programs that embraces all real estate industry sectors". It has local chapters which provide "networking and professional development".

Strathcona County Condominium Association
